\*Alaska, American Samoa, Arizona, Guam, Kansas, and South Carolina will not hold presidential preference votes. Congressional district delegates in Illinois and Pennsylvania will be elected directly on the ballot. None of these delegates will be allocated on a proportional or winner-take-all basis. Although Nevada is not holding a statewide presidential preference vote, delegates will be allocated proportionally based on the results of the Alternative Presidential Preference Poll.

# DELEGATE TYPES

## AT-LARGE

At-large (AL) delegates are statewide delegates, who must be residents of that state. Each state receives ten AL delegates, and bonus AL delegates are awarded based on recent Republican electoral success, including the election of a Republican governor, Republican U.S. Senator(s), a Republican majority of a state's congressional delegation, a Republican majority of one or all chambers of the state legislature, and a majority of the state's electoral votes having been cast for President Trump in 2016. Territories and the District of Columbia are awarded a specified number of AL delegates: American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, and the Virgin Islands receive six delegates each; the District of Columbia receives 16 delegates; and Puerto Rico receives 20 delegates.

## CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT

Congressional district (CD) delegates must be residents of and selected by the congressional district they represent. Each state is allocated three CD delegates per congressional district.

## REPUBLICAN NATIONAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Each state's three RNC members (national committeeman, national committeewoman, and state chairman) are automatically national convention delegates. These are the only automatic delegates and the only national convention delegates that do not have alternate delegates

# ALLOCATION METHODS

Most states choose to hold a statewide vote that permits a choice among candidates for the Republican nomination for President of the United States in a primary, caucuses, or a state convention. With the exception of delegates who appear on the primary ballot and are elected directly by voters, statewide presidential preference votes must be used to allocate and bind the state's delegation in either a proportional or winner-take-all manner.

## PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE VOTES

In 2020, 42 states will hold presidential primaries. Four states (Iowa, North Dakota, the Northern Mariana Islands, and the U.S. Virgin Islands) will hold presidential preference caucuses. Two states (Virginia & Wyoming) will hold presidential preference votes at their state conventions. Three states (American Samoa, Guam, and Kansas) will adopt resolutions at their state and/or CD conventions (or the equivalent caucus in American Samoa) regarding how delegates will be allocated and bound. Illinois CD delegates and all Arizona and Alaska delegates will indicate the candidate to whom they intend to be bound before they are selected as delegates. Nevada's Republican state committee will vote in an Alternative Presidential Preference Poll to allocate delegates. South Carolina will not allocate delegates, and they will proceed to the national convention unbound. Because there was only one candidate who qualified for the Hawaii Republican Presidential Caucus, all delegates will be allocated to that candidate, Donald Trump. In states that allow an uncommitted choice in the presidential preference vote, any delegates

allocated as uncommitted will not be bound to a presidential candidate at the national convention.

States may either allocate all AL and CD delegates together based on the statewide vote or allocate their AL delegates based on the statewide vote and the CD delegates based on the vote in each district. States may also use different allocation methods for AL and CD delegates. Unless states specifically choose to allocate them in a different manner, RNC members are allocated in the same manner as the AL delegates.

### **PROPORTIONAL**

Proportional methods of allocation divide the delegates among candidates based on the preference vote results. Proportional allocation is required for all states with preference votes between March 1 and March 14. Most proportional states have a minimum percentage (up to 20%) a candidate must achieve in order to win any delegates. Further, some proportional states award delegates on a winner-take-all basis to a candidate who receives a certain percentage (at least 50%) of the vote.

### **WINNER-TAKE-ALL**

The winner-take-all method of allocation provides that the plurality winner of the preference vote wins all of the delegates. States may not utilize this method to elect, select, allocate, or bind delegates before March 15.

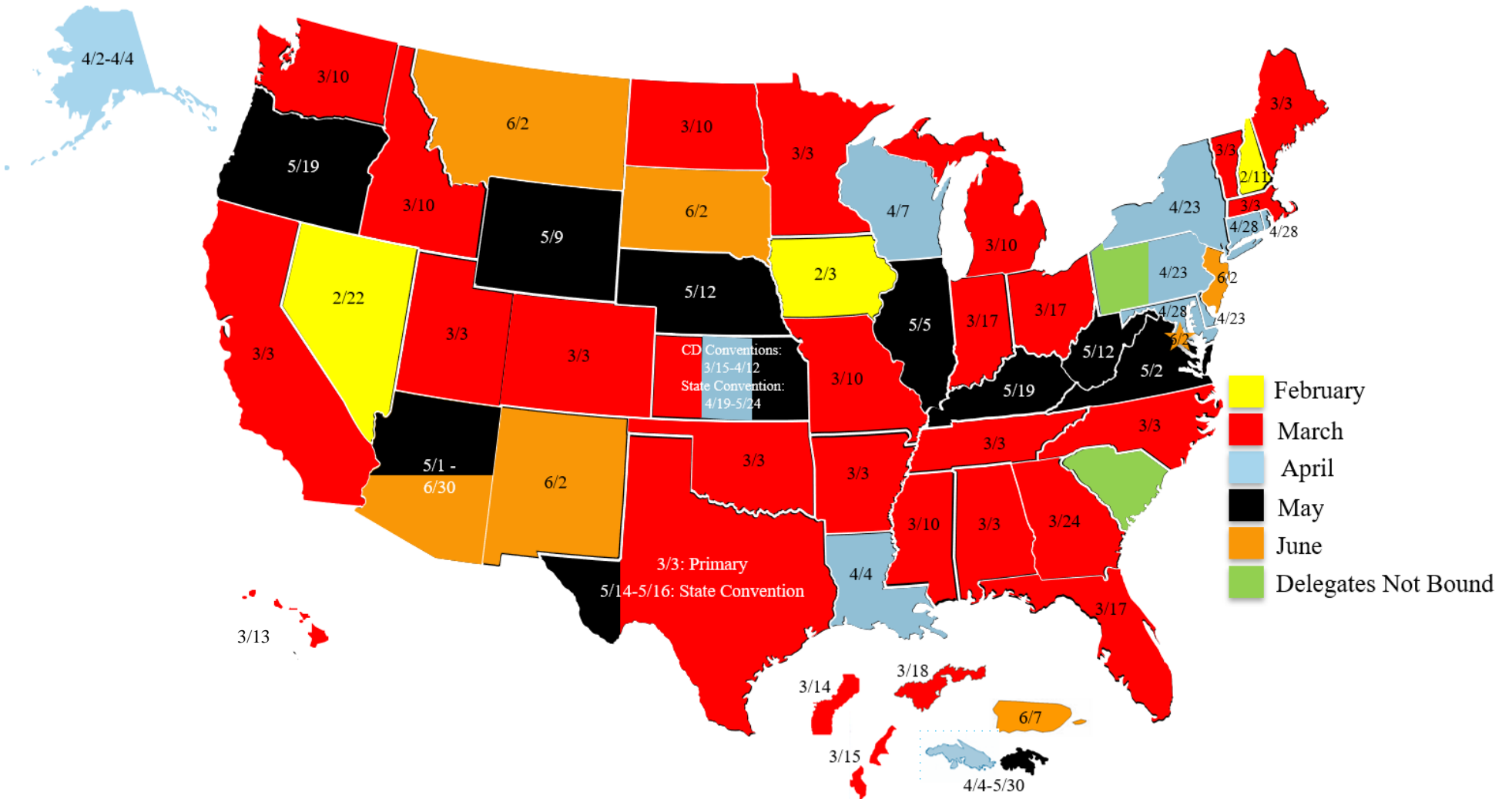
