# VOTE EARLY

up to 40 days before Nov. 3

Absentee voting allows early drop-off, in-person and mail-in voting

## Step 1: Make sure you're registered



Visit [Michigan.gov/Vote](https://Michigan.gov/Vote) to verify you are registered to vote OR to register online.

## Step 2: Apply for an absent voter ballot



Apply online at [Michigan.gov/Vote](https://Michigan.gov/Vote) to have your ballot or accessible ballot sent to you OR use the search tool to find your local election clerk's office to apply in person and receive your ballot. ***You can vote while you are there, beginning Sept. 24.***

## Step 3: Vote your ballot



Vote your ballot, then submit it at your clerk's drop box or office OR return it as soon as possible by mail (allow at least two weeks). **Ballots must be received by 8 p.m. on Election Day.**
