

# ***Keep Minnesota #1 in voter participation and help slow the spread of COVID-19!***



Minnesotans are working together to stay safe and keep each other healthy. In 2020 that means voting from home! In Minnesota, any eligible voter may choose to vote from home by requesting an absentee ballot. You may request your ballot for the **November 3, 2020 General Election**.

## **Steps to Vote from Home**

1. Request your ballot online at [mnvotes.org](http://mnvotes.org).
2. If you don't have internet access, or if you prefer to return the form by mail, you can complete the enclosed Absentee Ballot Request form and sign and date it.
3. If you use the paper form, mail it *as soon as possible* to ensure time for your ballot to be mailed to you. Postage is paid, there is no need to attach any stamps! Most places begin mailing out ballots about 6 weeks ahead of Election Day.
4. Follow the instructions to vote and return your ballot when you receive it in the mail.
5. Track the status of your ballot and confirm that it was received and accepted at [mnvotes.org](http://mnvotes.org).

All eligible voters are encouraged to Vote From Home, but polling places will be open on Election Day for those who need or want to vote in person.

To vote in Minnesota's **November 3** general election, you must be a registered voter. You can check your registration online at [www.mnvotes.org](http://www.mnvotes.org).
